3. TEAM QUOTAS & RULES

LICENSES:

Only competitors and team officials holding a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

REGISTRATION OF TEAM AND COMPETITORS:

Member Federation may register, within statutory deadlines, team officials for one of the following roles:

- a) One (1) Head of Delegation
- b) Up to three (3) coaches per discipline
- c) Up to three (3) qualified medical or para-medical personnel

Member Federations may register as competitors:

- a) any current youth European Champions (who shall be registered for the discipline in which they are champion)
- b) up to three (3) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline or up to four (4) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline for host country

REGISTRATION FEES:

€ 40,- for each competitor per discipline.

Please pay the registration fee of Euro 30,- cash at the registration desk. Euro 10,- per competitor will be charged by IFSC Europe to the national federation.

For the registration on 30th April it is necessary for all team managers to show the passports or ID-cards of their competitors to get them registered.

VISA APPLICATION PROCEDURE

(LEAD, SPEED, BOULDER)

After processing the personal data submitted to the LOC in a special EXCEL form (ANNEX 1) NO LATER THAN 27th of MARCH, you will receive a telex number which have to be written in the visa application form on the consulate web-site. It is to be submitted to any Russian Consulate or its authorized Visa Handling Service Centre regardless of citizenship along with other personal documents (such as the passport, the necessary number of pictures, completed application form, etc.) for visa processing in person or by a representative. As the above visa procedure is exceptional, please make sure to mention that you are applying for the Russian visa to attend the European Youth Climbing Championships 2021.

Some consulates of the Russian Federation accept postal applications. Though there is a number of consulates, where personal attendance is required for fingerprints. All details are to be checked on the consular website in advance.

Here is some useful information for completing a visa application form on the website: In the field 'Purpose of visit (section)' please choose 'science-culture-sports-religion'; in the following field 'Purpose of visit' 'Sport relations' is to be chosen. In this case 'Visa category and type' will automatically come as 'common humanitarian'. Or if you have a media ID, you choose 'business visits' in the field 'Purpose of visit (section)', 'mass media business trip' in the field 'Purpose of visit' and in this case 'Visa category and type' will automatically come as 'common business'.

The completed Form with the personal data is to be provided in EXCEL format and e-mailed to visa@c-f-r.ru

Important to remember:

1. Make sure that each passport has two blank visa-designated pages.

- 2. Make sure that the expiry date of the passport is at least six months after the last day of the expected stay in Russia.
- 3. If the passport does not meet these two requirements, a new passport must be obtained or the existing one is to be prolonged before you can request the invitation letter.
